There's nothing especially difficult about nesting CASE statements in SQL, but I guess it could be confusing sometimes.

Here's an example:

```
case [group]
  when 'C' then
    case control
      when 1 then
        case phase
          when 1 then 'Initial Diary'
          when 2 then '8 week pause'
          when 3 then 'Ending Diary'
          else 'unknown'
        end
      end
    else
      case phase
        when 1 then 'Initial Diary'
        when 2 then 'Learing Modules'
        when 3 then 'Ending Diary'
        else 'unknown'
      end
    end
  when 'P' then 'Parent Modules'
end as phaseText
```
